Please bring the following items to school in August.

Items that will be shared in the classroom:

- 1 package of 12 #2 pencils (already sharpened is best)
- 4 boxes of crayons
- 1 pair of scissors (there's scissors for **left-handle**)
- 4 lysol/clorox disinfecting wipes
- 3 boxes of facial tissues
- 2 bottles of hand sanitizer
- 4 large glue sticks
- 1 bottle of white glue
- 20 erasers (pencil cap style)
- 3 pack of 3 beveled erasers
- 1 pkg gallon size freezer Ziploc bags (BOYS)
- 1 pkg pint/sandwich size freezer Ziploc bags (GIRLS)
- 12 **EXPO** dry erase markers different colors
- 1 pkg copy paper 500 sheets
- 6 tubs play doh (different colors)
- 4 sharpie permanent marker
- 2 copy paper assorted colors (100 sheets)
- 2 plastic rulers
- 1 refill box of clear scotch tape
