### Items that will be shared in the classroom:

- 5 package of 12 #2 pencils sharpened (**plain, non-decorated**)
- 1 package of 8-12 color pencils
- 3 boxes facial tissues
- 2 clorox disinfecting wipes
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer 30 oz.
- 3 large glue stick
- 1 white glue
- 6 rubber erasers
- 1 ruler
- 1 protractor (**4 inches bigs**)
- 1 pack of index cards
- 1 pack with blue, black, green, red pens
- 6-8 dry-erase markers (primary colors) (EXPO)
- 1 clear plastic ruler with inches and centimeters
- 1 geometry kit (with compass, protractor and triangles)
- 1 paper towel roll
- 1 pkg gallon size freezer Ziploc bags
- 1 pkg copy paper 500 sheets each
- 2 scotch tape
