Dear Parent/Guardian:

According to the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 (Public Law 107-110), our district is required to inform you of certain information. Upon your request, SLLIS is required to provide to you, in a timely manner, the following information:

- Whether a teacher has met state qualification and licensing criteria for the grade levels and subject areas in which the teacher provides instruction.
- Whether the teacher is teaching under emergency or other provisional status through which state qualification or licensing criteria have been waived.
- Whether your child is provided services by paraprofessionals and, if so, what their qualifications are.
- What baccalaureate degree major a teacher has and any other graduate certification or degree held by the teacher, and the field of discipline of the certification.

In addition to the information that you may request, districts must provide to each individual parent:

- Information on the achievement level of the parent's student in each of the Missouri state academic assessments.
- Timely notice that the parent's student has been assigned or has been taught for four or more consecutive weeks by a teacher who is not highly qualified.
